Fort Frederick Flag Pole Fund Raising Campaign

In August of 1755, His Excellency Governor Horatio Sharpe of Maryland ordered "a Black & Yellow Flagg 24 feet long and 16 feet broad with the Union in One Corner" from Silvanus Grove a merchant in London. This large flag was destine to fly over historic Fort Frederick during the French and Indian War. In order to fly a copy of this wonderful flag at Fort Frederick again the Friends of Fort Frederick State Park are undertaking a campaign to raise \$60,000 to construct a 75 foot tall authentic flag pole in the fort's Northwest bastion. Imagine driving into the park and before your eyes this magnificent flag flutters in the wind welcoming all visitors to Maryland's one of a kind fort, Fort Frederick.
